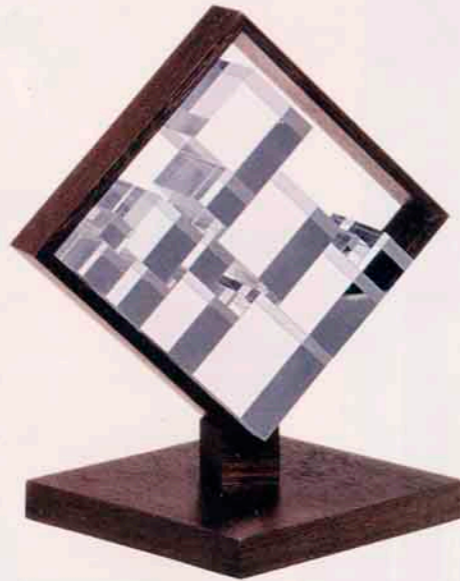


## BEST BETS

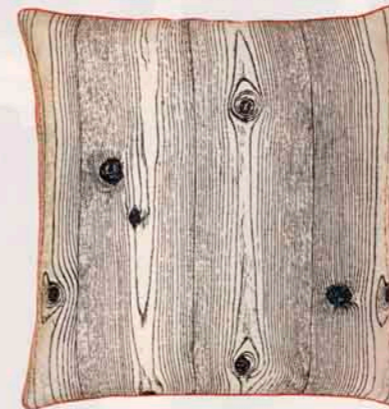


**OFF THE CUFF**
